Respected Sir/Madam, the war started between Russia & Ukraine and our own students were neither the reason nor responsible for the war; But unfortunate are these innocent students getting somewhat step motherly treatment after they reached India.

For the last so many months no straight instructions or words of guidance were issued for these students; neither by the Government of India nor by the **National Medical Commission**; so what has happened – the Medical Education Consultants are playing with the emotions & future of these students. Question No 1. - Who approached NMC with the proposal of a Mobility programme on behalf of Ukraine Universities?

Question No 2. - Which are the Ukraine Universities running mobility programmes officially and in which country?

The list of such Ukraine Universities running such activity must come from the **Government of Ukraine** through **The Embassy of India**, Kiev, Ukraine not individuals.

Question No 3. - Since you have not mentioned any country in the notification; does this notification mean that the Mobility programme can be run in India too?

Question No 4. - In the notification you have mentioned that the process must satisfy Screening Test Regulations 2002; does this mean the Ist Year students who joined Session September 2021; but flew after 18.11.2021 can join a mobility programme in another country with the rest of the students from 2nd to 6th year or NOT.

Question No 5. - There is news circulating among students that some of the universities have already got permission from the Universities in Ukraine as well as the National Medical Commission to run a Mobility programme in India. Is this true?

This notification dated 06/09/2022 needs clarity so that the students do not get misled; I request you to kindly clarify the above questions may be through reply to me too or once again through FAQs on NMC Website.

Kindly act today before damage is done by these Medical Education Consultants causing loss of money, time & future of the innocent students.


PUBLIC NOTICE

However, the degree will be awarded by the parent Ukrainian University.
